

## **Don't Overlook DC SEVEN's EZ Enhancer**

Sure, DC7 has lots more capability in noise reduction. There are all kinds of new filter approaches that let you push the filtering hard for a better result.

But that's not all that is new with DC7. As you get your copy, make sure you don't overlook the new EZ Enhancer tool. This single tool brings together a whole list of enhancement technologies in one easy to use simple interface. Enhancement will likely be one of your last steps in a project. First, you'll analyze the recording and decide on an approach. Next, you'll remove noise and lastly you may attempt to Enhance the audio by making it sound more alive, more accurate or just plain better.

The EZ Enhancer tool is deceptively simple - a volume control, three tone controls and a single exciter slider. That's it. But under the hood, this thing is a powerhouse set up to make your audio sound great. The key to this tool is not so much the available controls, but the presets included with it.

Here's a tip for you that you may not know about selecting presets. Get started by bring up the EZ Enhancer tool. Next open the file you want to enhance. Now click on Preview in the EZ Enhancer to start the audio playing.

Now here's the trick. While the audio is playing, drop the preset box and go all the way to the top and choose "audiophile quality". You'll hear the effect. It's nice. However, you can also try other effects. Next, hit the down arrow key on your keyboard. The next preset in the list will be selected and you'll hear this one. Remember, all this time the audio is playing so you are hearing the enhancer. As long as the preset was the LAST thing you clicked on, you'll be able to scroll thru all the presets with just your arrow keys so that you can quickly and easily audition them.

Here's an example for you - right now I'm listening to Help by the Beatles. This is a loud song and there is an acoustic guitar in it that is really nice. Most of the time, you can't hear it, however. With EZ Enhancer's "Well Balanced Exciter" preset along with an adjustment of the exciter slider, we can hear the guitar very well by bringing it a bit more out front.

The EZ Enhancer is a very powerful tool unique to DC7 that can add a variety of effects to your audio. Try them and find the one that makes you say "Wow!"
