

Stereo Simulation with the Diamond Cut Echo Effect

DC Six contains many new features, but one of the unsung heroes may be the Echo effect. This tool is great for giving your audio that grand canyon feeling, but it can do so much more. If you have mono audio such as 78s, early 45s and lps, or mono tapes, you'll be amazed how much better they'll sound if we simulate a bit of stereo with them. There are four new stereo simulation presets in the Diamond Cut Echo filter that will serve as good starting points for you. Like always, you can just listen and adjust. This is a lot of fun in that you can close your eyes and hear the sound field change as you move the sliders. Quite cool. If you are restoring old mono recordings, don't forget to try the new stereo simulator as it'll make your audio sound dramatically more alive.
